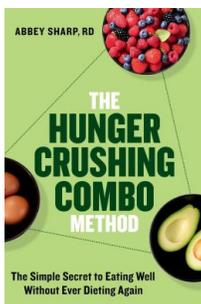

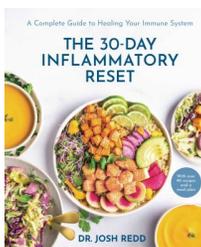
RPL's Recommended Reads

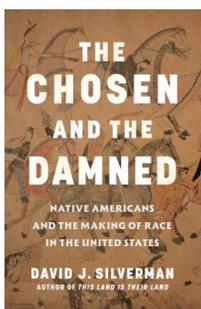
